

EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in Certain Kitchen Appliance Shelving and Racks from China,

Inv. Nos. 701-TA-458 and 731-TA-1154 (Review)

On November 4, 2014, the Commission determined to conduct expedited five-year reviews of the referenced orders pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(b) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(b)). Refrigeration Shelving

With respect to certain refrigeration shelving and baskets for refrigerators, freezers, combination refrigerator/freezers and other refrigerating or freezing equipment (herein "refrigeration shelving"), the Commission received a joint response to the notice of institution from Nashville Wire Products, Inc. ("Nashville Wire") and SSW Holding Company, Inc. ("SSW"). The Commission found the individual response of each of these domestic producers to be adequate. Because these producers collectively accounted for a substantial portion of U.S. refrigeration shelving production, the Commission further determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. The Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

Oven Racks

With respect to certain oven racks, side racks, and subframes for cooking stoves, ranges, and ovens (herein "oven racks"), the Commission received a joint response to the notice of institution from Nashville Wire and SSW. The Commission found the individual response of each of these domestic producers to be adequate. Because these producers collectively accounted for a substantial portion of U.S. oven rack production, the Commission further determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. The Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews with respect to certain kitchen appliance shelving and racks. The Commission, therefore, determined to conduct expedited reviews of the orders.
