

EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATIONS ON ADEQUACY

in

Preserved Mushrooms from Chile, China, India, and Indonesia
Inv. Nos. 731-TA-776-779 (Third Review)

On June 5, 2015, the Commission unanimously determined to conduct expedited reviews in the subject five-year reviews pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a joint response to its notice of institution from L.K. Bowman, Monterey Mushrooms Inc., and The Mushroom Company, domestic producers of preserved mushrooms. The Commission found each domestic producer's individual response to be adequate. The Commission unanimously determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate because it received data from producers accounting for a substantial share of domestic production in 2014.

The Commission also unanimously determined that the respondent interested party group response to the notice of institution was inadequate, as no respondent interested party filed a response to the notice of institution.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews. Therefore, the Commission decided to conduct expedited reviews of these orders.
