

EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in

Carbazole Violet Pigment 23 from China and India
Inv. Nos. 701-TA-437 and 731-TA-1060-1061 (Second Review)

On July 6, 2015, the Commission unanimously determined to conduct expedited reviews in the subject five-year reviews pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a joint response to its notice of institution from Nation Ford Chemical Co. and Sun Chemical Corp., domestic producers of carbazole violet pigment 23. The Commission found each domestic producer's individual response to be adequate. The Commission unanimously determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate because it received data from producers accounting for a substantial share of domestic production of carbazole violet pigment 23 in 2014.

The Commission also unanimously determined that the respondent interested party group response to the notice of institution was inadequate, as no respondent interested party filed a response to the notice of institution.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews. Therefore, the Commission decided to conduct expedited reviews of these orders.
