

## EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in

### *Wooden Bedroom Furniture from China Inv. No. 731-TA-1058 (Second Review)*

On February 5, 2016, the Commission unanimously determined to conduct a full review in the subject five-year review pursuant to section 751(c) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c).

The Commission received an adequate individual response to the notice of institution on behalf of the American Furniture Manufacturers Committee for Legal Trade, an association that includes 11 U.S. producers of wooden bedroom furniture. The Commission also received adequate individual responses on behalf of domestic producers Ashley Furniture Industries, Inc. and Vaughan-Bassett Furniture Company, Inc. Because the Commission received adequate responses from interested parties accounting for a substantial share of U.S. production of wooden bedroom furniture, the Commission unanimously determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission received individually adequate responses from four producers of wooden bedroom furniture in China: Dorbest Limited (Rui Feng Woodwork Co., Ltd., Rui Feng Lumber Development Co., Ltd.); Guangdong Yihua Timber Industry Co., Ltd.; Zhangjiagang Daye Hotel Furniture Co., Ltd.; and Zhangzhou Guo Hui Industrial & Trade Co., Ltd. The Commission also received individually adequate responses from Ashley Furniture Industries, Inc.; Hooker Furniture Corporation; and New Classic Home Furnishings Inc., each of which import the subject merchandise.

Because these combined firms produced, exported, or imported substantial quantities of the subject merchandise from China, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was adequate. Accordingly, the Commission determined to proceed to a full review.
