

EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in

Porcelain-on-Steel Cooking Ware from China
Inv. No. 731-TA-298 (Fourth Review)

On May 6, 2016, the Commission unanimously determined to conduct an expedited review in the subject five-year review pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a response to the notice of institution from Columbian Home Products, LLC, the sole U.S. producer of porcelain-on-steel cooking ware. The Commission found the domestic producer's individual response to be adequate. The Commission unanimously determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate because the responding domestic producer accounted for all U.S. porcelain-on-steel cooking ware production in 2015.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that warranted conducting a full review. Therefore, the Commission determined to conduct an expedited review of the antidumping duty order.
