

## EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in

*Stainless Steel Wire Rod from India*  
Inv. No. 731-TA-638 (Fourth Review)

On March 6, 2017, the Commission unanimously determined to conduct an expedited review in the subject five-year review pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a response to the notice of institution from three domestic producers of stainless steel wire rod: Carpenter Technology Corporation; North American Stainless; and Universal Stainless & Alloy Products, Inc. The Commission found each domestic interested party's response to be individually adequate. The Commission further determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate because the responding domestic producers accounted for substantially all domestic production of stainless steel wire rod in 2015.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission also found that there were no other circumstances warranting a full review. Therefore, the Commission determined to conduct an expedited review of the antidumping duty order on stainless steel wire rod.
