

## EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION OF ADEQUACY

in

*Light-Walled Rectangular Pipe and Tube from Taiwan*  
Inv. No. 731-TA-410 (Fourth Review)

On April 10, 2017, the Commission determined to conduct an expedited review in the subject five-year review pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a single response filed jointly by Allied Tube and Conduit; Atlas Tube; Bull Moose Tube Company; California Steel and Tube; Hannibal Industries, Inc.; Maruichi American Corporation; Searing Industries; and Western Tube & Conduit Corporation, domestic producers of light-walled rectangular (LWR) pipe and tube. The Commission unanimously found each individual response to be adequate. Because the Commission received a response from interested parties accounting for a substantial share of U.S. production of LWR pipe and tube in 2016, the Commission unanimously determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission also unanimously determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate, as no respondent interested party filed a response to the notice of institution.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting a full review. The Commission, therefore, determined to conduct an expedited review of the order.
