

## EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in

*Steel Nails from the United Arab Emirates*  
Inv. No. 731-TA-1185 (Review)

On July 7, 2017, the Commission unanimously determined to conduct expedited reviews in the subject five-year reviews pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a response to the notice of institution from Mid Continent Steel & Wire, a domestic producer of steel nails. The Commission found the domestic interested party's response to be individually adequate. Because the responding domestic producer accounted for a substantial portion of domestic steel nail production in 2016, the Commission unanimously determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive any response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting a full review and determined to conduct an expedited review of the antidumping duty order.
